



Donits used to treat nausea and vomiting, relief from symptoms associated with gastroparesis including loss of appetite, bloating & belching with and after meal.

**Composition:** Each ml contains Domperidone 1 mg

Pharmacological Group: Anti-emetic

#### **Indications**

- It is indicated in the treatment of epigastric sense of fullness.
- Upper abdominal distension
- Regurgitation
- Nausea and Vomiting

**Proposed Route of Administration:** Oral liquid Suspension It is recommended to take oral Domperidone before meals. If taken after meals, absorption of the drug is somewhat delayed.

#### **Adults:**

## Adults and adolescents (over 12 years and weighing 35 kg or more)

The initial duration of treatment is four weeks. Patients should be re-evaluated after four weeks and the need for continued treatment re-assessed. 10 ml to 20 ml (of oral suspension containing Domperidone 1mg per ml) three to four times per day with a maximum daily dose of 80 ml.

### Infants and children

0.25 - 0.5 mg/kg three to four times per day with a maximum daily dose of 2.4 mg/kg (but do not exceed 80 mg per day).

Proposed Storage Conditions: Store below 25°C in a dry and cool place. Protect from heat, light and moisture.

Pack Size: 60ml, 120ml suspension, Tablets


