



Ibuprofen is a nonsteroidal anti-inflammatory drug used for treating pain, fever, and inflammation, includes painful menstrual periods, migraines and rheumatoid arthritis.

Composition: Each 5ml contains Ibuprofen (BP) 100 mg

Pharmacological Group: Analgesics, Antipyretic, Anti-Inflammatory

## **Indications:**

Treating minor aches, pains caused by the common cold, headaches, toothaches, back or muscle aches, menstrual cramps, or arthritis. It may be used to reduce fever in children and adults.

**Proposed Route of Administration:** Oral liquid Suspension

## **Proposed Dosage:**

Actual Dosage must be determined by the qualified Physician:

## CHILDREN:

Fever Reduction: For fever in children, 6 months to 12 years of age: The recommended dose is 5 mg/kg

The recommended maximum daily dose is 40 mg/kg. Or as directed by qualified physician according to requirements.

## **ADULTS:**

400 mg every 4 to 6 hours as necessary for the relief of mild to moderate pain in adults or as directed by physician according to indications.

**Proposed Storage Conditions:** Store below 30°C in a dry and cool place.

Protect from heat, light and moisture.

Pack size: 90ml suspension, shake it well before use.
